## More About Sanctuary House

Sanctuary House is a private residential building owned and operated by the Generation To Generation Society, a non-profit organization. The main function of Sanctuary House is to provide safe and affordable living accommodations in a peaceful environment for both our short-term guests and the individual residents who live here.

Located in the south end of downtown Trail at 1705 Bay Avenue, Sanctuary House provides alternative short-term, low cost accommodations for individuals or families travelling to Trail to access medical services provided at the Kootenay Boundary Regional Hospital.

Sanctuary House is a six apartment building complex. Two apartments located on the second floor have been designated for short-term, out-of-town guests. Depending on your individual or family situation, you can choose between a one bedroom or two bedroom apartment.

## Your Participation

In order to maintain our goal of providing affordable short-term accommodations, your participation (if you are physically able to do so) in helping us prepare your apartment for the next guest would be greatly appreciated.

When your stay at Sanctuary House has come to a close, following the short cleaning checklist that is posted in each of our guest apartments will help ensure a clean and orderly environment for the next guest.

We have attempted to anticipate your needs while staying with us. The suites are fully equipped and also provide emergency toiletry articles that you may need.

As we are a non-profit society, we would appreciate the replacement of any items that you may use.

## What's Covered?

The Accommodation Fee covers your rent and utilities for the length of your stay. We have provided a TV and DVD player because there is no cable hook up. There is no telephone in the apartments, so please obtain a cell phone or use public phones.
